
Best Proof Yet! Donald Trump IS in Bible Prophecy!

On this program I want to give you the best proof yet that our new president, Donald Trump, is indeed found in Bible prophecy, and that is specifically in Micah, chapter number 5. And I know for many of you there is no such thing as proof; God would have to write his name in the sky before you would believe it. But I do think that by September 23rd, the date of the Great Sign, I think a lot of you will come to understand this prophecy.



First let's look at Micah's chart because this is how he sealed up his prophecy.

You have to rearrange the verses to understand the meaning and we've already looked at verses 1, 5, 3, 7, 10, and 13 and on this program, to find the proof I am talking about, we will look at verses 2,4 and 6; verse number 2: 'And you, Bethlehem Ephrata, are a little one among the thousands of Judah: out of you shall he come forth unto me that is to be the ruler in Israel and his going forth is from the beginning, from the days of eternity.' Let's go through this part by part and how in the world does Bethlehem Ephrata refer to Donald Trump?

In the near time fulfillment of this prophecy, Bethlehem referred to the birthplace of our Lord, Jesus Christ. Now there are, believe it or not, some people who don't even accept that as proof. Of course, it's pretty obvious; but I know you are going to say, well Donald Trump was not

born in Bethlehem or Ephrata; how can this refer to him? Notice Micah does not say 'born in'; he says 'come forth from'. If this were just a near time prophecy, Micah would have said 'born in' Bethlehem because that would have fit Jesus; but this prophecy must fit both Jesus and the End Times fulfillment in Donald Trump. And of course, you're going to say, how does Bethlehem Ephrata refer at all to Donald Trump? If you know your geography, there is one state in the United States that has communities named both Bethlehem and Ephrata and that state is Pennsylvania. I know you're going to say, Donald Trump was not born in Pennsylvania. But let repeat, Micah does not say 'born in' he says 'come forth from'. So how does Donald Trump 'come forth from' Pennsylvania? Well, it's very interesting, he received his higher education in Pennsylvania; he graduated from the Wharton School of Business. That's where he learned how to make his billions of dollars. So, like Jesus Christ in the near time fulfillment, in these End Times, I can't think of a more significant proof that Bethlehem Ephrata, that is Pennsylvania, is where Donald Trump comes forth from.

The next phrase, 'ruler in Israel' we've discussed before. Israel is Micah's code word for the remnant Catholic Church and his 'going forth is from the beginning, from the days of eternity' means that Donald Trump's mission has been known by Almighty God from the beginning and it is very significant. I've been saying all along that Donald Trump is going to be the 'Pope', so to speak, of the remnant Catholic Church. It will be his mission to lead us in its End Times battle against the Antichrist; he will lead the 'stone cut from the mountain' in Daniel 2.

Let's look at verse number 4: 'And he shall stand and feed in the strength of the Lord and the height of the name of the Lord his God; and they shall be converted, for now shall he be magnified even to the ends of the earth'. Now, this is the second time Micah is talking about Donald Trump and his Protestant brethren as being converted. Some Bibles have weaker words like 'abide' but 'convert' is much better because Isaiah also refers to this in his chapter number 45 where King Cyrus eventually knows Almighty God through receiving treasures and money, which I believe refers to the Catholic faith, which will be given to Donald Trump. In other words, both he, Donald Trump, and they, his Protestant brethren, will be converted and they, both Donald Trump and the United States, will be magnified to the ends of the earth.

So now, let's look at verse number 6: 'And they (Donald Trump's converted brethren) shall feed the land of Assyria with the sword, in the land of Nimrod with the spears thereof and he shall deliver us from the Assyrian ('us', by the way refers, to the remnant Catholics: we are the ones to whom Micah is addressing chapter number 5; read the first verse) and he shall deliver us from the Assyrian, when he shall come into our land and when he shall tread in our borders.' This is a very interesting reference by Micah to 'borders'. Wasn't that Donald Trump's most important promise during his campaign, that he would secure our borders? That is not accidental, people. Micah is prophesying about Donald Trump here and you have to be pretty blind not to understand exactly what he is saying. Notice by the way that word 'feed' the land of Assyria. That connects verse number 6 with verse number 4 in this new arrangement 'where he shall stand and feed in the strength of the Lord'. Now, as I say, some Bibles don't say 'feed' some say 'shepherd', but it is nonetheless a connection between verse number 4 and verse number 6 which you would not find in your Bibles in the original sequence of these verses.

So, in conclusion, I think it's pretty obvious that verses 2, 4 and 6 are all about Donald Trump and his converted Protestant brethren. As I say, we may not understand this fully until September 23rd, but we are already beginning to see Donald Trump change in his attitude. His whole life has been a learning experience. Certainly in his past he has not lived an exemplary life but that's why he needs to convert and he will convert. Until the date of September 23rd, we and the remnant Catholic Church will not get benefits from Donald Trump. He is struggling with his own Republican Party to get his agenda through Congress. Micah says that we will be supported instead by seven shepherds and eight princes and that's also part of this amazing prophecy. And I know some of you will not consider this proof, but for you there is no proof possible. But for most of us, I think we will understand exactly what both Isaiah and Micah are prophesying about in these End Times.
