

Pope Francis Marries Couples Living in Sin

The headline this morning all over the Internet was **'Pope Francis Marries Couples Living in Sin'** and my first reaction was *'Good for them! People who are fornicating should get married!'* But that's not the real problem with what the Pope did. Personally, I think he is trying to prove that he is indeed the False Prophet.



Let's read an article from the Daily Telegraph this morning on the Internet: **'Pope Francis married twenty couples on Sunday, some of whom had already lived together and had children, in the latest sign that the Argentine pontiff wants the Catholic Church to be more inclusive.'** Well, sure, the Catholic Church is a hospital for sinners but Pope Francis nowhere said in his homily that fornication was a sin.

'In the first wedding he had performed in his eighteen-month-old papacy, the Pope took each couple through their vows in turn, including Gabriella and Guido who already had children and thought such a marriage would be impossible, official broadcasting service Radio Vaticana said. The people getting married on Sunday are couples like many others, the Diocese of Rome said in a statement. Some already live together, some already have children.' This fulfills the prophecy of Revelation chapter 11, verse 2 which says that the **'holy city will be trampled underfoot by the Gentiles.'**

The Diocese of Rome is making a grave mistake and they are proving that prophecy has been fulfilled and none of us Catholics can any longer trust anything that comes out of the Vatican. **'The Pope said marriage was real life, not some TV show.'** I guess that's supposed to be some kind of a joke. **'The Vatican views sex outside of marriage as sin** (well, the Vatican used to regard sex outside of marriage as sin) **but Pope Francis stresses the Church should be a forgiving one.'** Why yes, Jesus told the woman caught in adultery that her sins were forgiven her but he also told her to go and sin no more.

'The Pope has said the Church must end its obsession with teachings on abortion, contraception, and homosexuality and

become more merciful.’ He said this a few months ago, however, he is mistaken. It is society that must stop promoting abortion, contraception, and homosexuality. So what is wrong with the Pope marrying couples who were living in sin? Why does this ceremony mark him as the False Prophet? And the reason is because he also married couples who were not living in sin! The article did not mention that part of the story. In other words, Pope Francis was trying to level the playing field. He did not distinguish between those who were living in sin and those who were not living in sin and of course, that's one of the aims of the False Prophet.

And now, here's how Yahoo News covered this story: ***‘Pope breaks taboo by marrying couples who lived in sin.’*** That word ‘taboo’ is an interesting choice isn't it? You think of taboo as something associated with pagan or primitive societies. Yahoo is editorializing here. They're trying to say that to consider fornication as a sin, is primitive and it's time for the Church to enter into the 21st century. Now, those are my words but that's the impression they are trying to give you.

‘A single mother, people who have been married before, and couples who have been living together in sin were married by Pope Francis in a taboo challenging ceremony (this is comical) at the Vatican on Sunday. In another signal of the openness of his papacy, Francis asked to marry forty people from different social backgrounds who would be a realistic (check that word ‘realistic’) sample of modern couples. Popes very rarely perform marriages. The last one was in 2000.’ And this article continues: ***‘The last time a pope performed a marriage was under the leadership of John Paul II in 2000 and before that in 1994. It comes three weeks before a major Synod of the Catholic Church which will discuss the divisive issues of marriage, divorce and contraception.’***

And let me clue you in right now, that will be a very significant conclave of the bishops and I will most certainly report on it because I think the False Prophet, Pope Francis, is going to show his hand at that Synod. ***‘The Church ban on allowing divorcees who have remarried to receive Communion is one of the key topics out for a debate (I'm glad that the news media at least focuses in on this issue; this is extremely important) and resolving deep divisions over the issue inside the Church is seen as a key test of Francis' leadership.’***

And there's no doubt Pope Francis has tipped his hand here also. If you remember, back in the last week of April, the Pope phoned a woman in Argentina who was living with a man who was not her husband, who had been divorced. They had a civil marriage, not a religious marriage and the Pope contradicted her local pastor and said that she could receive Communion. He said: **'that priest was more papal than the Pope.'** In other words, he mocked her Pastor. That was another huge error on the part of the Pope, in fact, his action fulfilled Daniel because at that point, he was just beginning to take away the Daily Sacrifice from the Prince.

And I'm sure you remember, within the week, after the Pope took the Daily Sacrifice away from the Prince, this horrible mark of the beast One World Government Religion symbol appeared at the canonization of those two popes, and this occurred on the 27th.
