

## Another Nuclear War Bible Prophecy

A lot of my subscribers have been asking me about the Boston Marathon terrorist bombings, and so far I have declined because, that warning to America is really obvious to just about everybody, and it is not my job to reveal the obvious. My job as a Co-Prophet is to explain the hidden prophecies, as found in the Bible, for example, in Revelation, chapter 7, verses 9-17: that is a prophecy about nuclear war, and I want to talk about that prophecy on this program.

And the reason is, because that passage was read at all Catholic Churches throughout the world this past weekend. However, I doubt very much if your pastor commented on the passage as a nuclear war warning, and yet that's exactly what it is. I know in my own church, Father O'Brien commented on it, and he did make a few very interesting comments, but not about the prophecy as it refers to us in our own time or that we will suffer through nuclear warfare.

So, let me read this passage and I will try to explain it as I go along and, as I say, this is chapter 7, starting with verse number 9: ***'After this I saw a great multitude which no man could number of all nations and tribes and peoples and tongues standing before the throne and in sight of the lamb clothed with white robes and palms in their hands.'*** Now, in my church, Father O'Brien made the very telling comment that this is an answer to Jehovah Witnesses who say that only 144,000 will go to heaven.

Obviously, in this passage, John sees a number that he cannot even count and elsewhere in Revelation, John counts up to 200 million, so we know that this number must be greater than that and is undoubtedly in the billions and we know that this group consists of martyrs. That's why they wear white and why they are holding palms. So we need to understand that there will be a great many people in heaven but they do not necessarily die a natural death.

And John continues in verse number 10: ***'And they cried with a loud voice saying, salvation to our God who sits upon the throne and to the lamb, and all the angels stood round the throne and the ancients and the four living creatures and they fell down before the throne upon their faces and adored God saying, Amen. Benediction and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving, honor and power and strength to our God forever and ever.'***

By the way, I should mention that I am reading from the Catholic Bible: this is the Douay Rheims translation. ***‘And one of the ancients answered and said to me: These that are clothed in white robes, who are they and whence came they?’*** Now, this is a very interesting question; it’s extremely important for those of us living in these End Times. ***‘And I said to him: My Lord, you know. And he said to me: These are they who came out of the Great Tribulation and have washed their robes and have made them white in the blood of the Lamb.’*** So these are martyrs during the Great Tribulation, which as we know, Jesus said would be the worst period in the entire history of mankind and that is the time frame that we are almost upon.

And John continues in verse number 15: ***‘Therefore, they are before the throne of God and they serve him day and night in his temple and he that sits on the throne shall dwell over them. They shall no more hunger nor thirst, neither shall the sun fall on them nor any heat for the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall rule them and shall lead them to the fountains of the waters of life and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes.’*** So now, this is very interesting. What caused the martyrdom of these billions of people during the Tribulation?

Well, John answers that in a sort of hidden fashion. There are four ways that these people are martyred. John says that they no longer have to worry about hunger or thirst or the sun falling on them nor any heat. What could John mean by that? Some people probably analyze this as being a meteor or a comet striking the earth but remember, these billions of souls are martyrs and if they had been killed by a comet or a meteor, they would not be martyrs because that would be from the hand of God.

So this sun which kills them must be symbolic and in these End Times, it can only refer to nuclear warfare. In fact, the sun is a nuclear power plant so this is a very apt description. And so, in conclusion, we realize that these billions of martyrs are the result of nuclear warfare and that is in our very near future. And I, I doubt if your Catholic priests explained that to you but, then again, that is my job as a Co-Prophet.
