

Zachariah - Middle East Wars

This will be part 6 in my series on the End Times prophecies of Zachariah. And first of all, I want to apologize a little bit for my voice. I had a slight touch of bronchitis this past week and I'm feeling a lot better today. Anne Thyme told me that the Lord indicated to her that I have a lung problem. I think that's very possible. I did work for 26 years in a furniture factory and you're continually in an environment of sawdust and lacquer fumes, so I would not be surprised if it has affected to a degree my lung capacity. In any event, I will try to keep this program short and I want to continue looking at the second 11 verse section, or column, and the last 5 verses in particular.

But first I want to review verse number 5 of chapter 13 where Zachariah writes about Jesus: ***'But he shall say I am no prophet. I am a husbandman for Adam is my example from my youth.'*** And one of my subscribers took somewhat exception to this and here's what Jake Swarzak said: *'I observed the video but I recall nothing of Our Lord learning from Adam.'* And I admit, I don't think 'learning' is probably quite the correct phrase. Zachariah said that Adam was Jesus' example and what this means is that Jesus is the new Adam. He did not sin whereas Adam of course fell to temptation. And here is what Saint Paul says in Romans: ***'But death reigned from Adam unto Moses, even over them who had not sinned after the similitude of the transgression of Adam, who is a figure of him who was to come.'*** So this idea that Adam prefigured Jesus is found in both the New Testament and now we find it also in Zachariah in the Old Testament.

Next, let's look at verse numbers 1 and 2 of chapter 13 of Zachariah. ***'And it shall come to pass in that day,'*** now when Zachariah says ***'in that day'*** he is practically always talking about Armageddon, ***'says the Lord of hosts, that I will destroy the names of idols out of the earth...'*** So this is definitely Armageddon because God is doing the battling, and that would be the same as the Ezekiel 38 War, ***'...and they shall be remembered no more: and I will take away the false prophets,'*** that would include the False Prophet, ***'and the unclean spirit out of the earth,'*** and 'the unclean spirit' would be the Antichrist.

Verse 1: ***'In that day, there shall be a fountain open to the house of David, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem: for the washing of the***

sinner, and of the unclean woman,’ and of course, this refers to Jesus. Later on, Zachariah says ***‘living waters will come out of Jerusalem.’*** And I read those two verses, that is 2 and 1 in reverse because remember, these 11 verses form a chiasm with the first 11 verses of Zachariah and these verses are printed from bottom to top even though they must be read from top to bottom and that clarifies the prophecy for us. And therefore we find that these two verses are all about the Ezekiel 38 War, that is Armageddon.

And now, let's take a look at the last 3 verses in this section which are actually verses 12, 13 and 14 of chapter 12. We must also read these in reverse and we will find that here Zachariah is talking about the Daniel 9 War which is the war currently facing the Nation of Israel in the Middle East. Please do not listen to the false prophets who say that Middle East events are leading up to the Ezekiel 38 War. That is a total misinterpretation of Bible Prophecy. The people of Israel and the people of the United States must repent if they are going to avoid the devastation of the Daniel 9 War.

Verse 14, 13, 12: ***‘All the rest of the families, families and families apart, and their women apart. The families of the house of Nathan apart, and their women apart: the families of the house of Levi apart, and their women apart: the families of Semei apart, and their women apart. And the land shall mourn: families and families apart: the families of the house of David apart, and their women apart.’*** Zachariah is obviously talking here about division within families and this therefore can only refer to the Daniel 9 War.

Normally, verses 12, 13 and 14 would follow verse number 11 in chapter number 12. However, because of this new verse structure, we now realize that Zachariah is talking about an entirely different lamentation. In verse number 11, Zachariah is talking about the lamentation of the Jews in the End Times in Israel when they see Jesus return at Armageddon and recognize him as their Messiah and they see the wounds in his hands and they will lament their previous spiritual blindness. However, in this rearranged section, verses 14, 13 and 12, the Jews are lamenting because of the Daniel 9 War and the destruction of Jerusalem which comes at the beginning of the Great Tribulation.

Therefore we see there are two completely different mournings and we would not understand that if we did not realize Zachariah has sealed

up his prophecy in very much the same way that Daniel sealed up his prophecies.
