

Limo Fire: God's Warning to America

I'm going to skip my usual introduction because this is again just a very short video, a commentary on that horrible limousine fire out in San Francisco over the weekend. And quite a few people have commented that had to be a reference to Saint Matthew's parable of the Five Wise and Five Foolish Virgins and I believe they are correct.

Remember, with the Tower of Siloam, 18 died and Jesus said: ***'Do you think that those 18 were more guilty than anyone else in Judea? I tell you no but, unless you repent, you also will suffer the same fate.'*** And that is the same warning of this limo fire to America: unless you repent, you will suffer the same fate.
