

## Assassination of Brett Kavanaugh in Bible Prophecy?



About a week ago, I believe it was, Brett Kavanaugh's wife, Ashley, asked Americans to pray for her husband because he is under serious satanic attack, and she asked them to pray Psalm 40. And we have a problem because Psalm 40 in the Catholic Douay Rheims Bible is the same as Psalm 41 in the King James Bible. And there were quite a few videos posted in the past week and they all recited the King James Psalm 40, which is incorrect. The King James 41 corresponds to the Douay Rheims 40 and this is very significant.

As I was studying Psalm 40 over the weekend I realized that this is very significant; I believe it is an End Times prophecy about Brett Kavanaugh and I believe that's why the Holy Spirit inspired Ashley Kavanaugh to ask Americans to pray that specific Psalm. In this Psalm we find out that Brett Kavanaugh has many enemies, which we already know. They not only oppose his nomination but they are plotting an assassination; very serious! He will be opposed by a friend who will betray him; could that be Mark Judge? We will soon find out this week. However, God gives him the victory over the enemies. I believe that Psalm 40 is predicting Brett Kavanaugh will be confirmed to the Supreme Court and the reason God gives him the victory is because Brett Kavanaugh is concerned for the poor and the needy.

Let's go through Psalm 40, verse by verse, and see if you don't agree with me; there are just too many correspondences here that verify this is an End Times prophecy about Brett Kavanaugh. Verse number 1: **'Unto the end, a psalm for David himself.'** Now, that word "end" is not found in the King James Version. I think that is a clue this is an End Times prophecy. Verse number 2: **'Blessed is he that understands concerning the needy and the poor: the Lord will deliver him in the evil day.'** Brett Kavanaugh is facing an evil day; the Lord is going to deliver him! Why? Brett Kavanaugh is well known for volunteering all over the DC area in soup kitchens, for example, for the poor and the needy. This is a very perfect description of Brett Kavanaugh here in Psalm number 40.

Verse number 3: **'The Lord preserve him and give him life and make him blessed upon the earth and deliver him not up to the**

**will of his enemies.**' This is why Ashley wants us to pray this Psalm; it is for Brett Kavanaugh's protection. Verse 4: **'The Lord help him on his bed of sorrow: you have turned all his couch in his sickness.'** God will help Brett Kavanaugh in this trial. Verse number 5: **'I said, O Lord, be thou merciful to me: heal my soul for I have sinned against you.'** Well, that's interesting. Brett Kavanaugh has admitted that he did a lot of drinking in his high school and college days; he drank to excess. But he did not admit to any of the other crimes that he has been charged with. He calls them lies and smears and I believe he is right. Verse number 6: **'My enemies have spoken evil against me: (Sound familiar?) When shall he die and his name perish'**. These evil people on the left, they are doing more than just speaking evil. 'When shall he die and his name perish?' They are hoping that he dies and I would not be a bit surprised if they are plotting an assassination. This is why we have to pray this Psalm number 40. I hope President Trump has increased his security detail.

Verse number 7: **'And if he came in to see me, he spoke vanity: his heart gathered together iniquity to itself. When he goes abroad he tells it.'** Does this tell us that Brett Kavanaugh has a friend who he confides with but then he tells it abroad? Is there a traitor in Brett Kavanaugh's midst? I think that's what this verse is telling us. Verse number 8: **'All my enemies whispered together against me: they devised evils to me.'** That's a pretty good description of the Democrats on the Senate Judiciary Committee. Verse number 9: **'They determined against me an unjust word: shall he that sleeps rise up again no more?'** Wow, is that another reference to an assassination? I think that's very scary and I can see why Ashley is concerned about her husband's safety; and I believe she was inspired by the Holy Spirit to ask Americans to pray this Psalm number 40. Verse number 10: **'For even the man of peace, in whom I trusted, who ate my bread has raised his heel against me.'** That could be Mark Judge. Mark Judge was a confidant of Brett Kavanaugh. He has, so far, said he supports Brett Kavanaugh's version of the events. Could he, in the face of a million-dollar bribe, change his tune? The left is desperate to defeat Brett Kavanaugh. Paying Mark Judge a million dollars to change his testimony would be nothing to them! That would be money well spent; that would be like Judas receiving his thirty pieces of silver.

Verse number 11: **'But you, O Lord, have mercy on me, and raise me up again: and I will requite them.'** If Brett Kavanaugh is confirmed to the Supreme Court, will there be instances where his

tormentors now, are brought up on charges, possibly of treason? Is this one of the reasons they oppose him so much? I saw a video on YouTube just a few days ago and that was his point. He said 'Roe v Wade' is a subterfuge; that's not the real issue to them; they are more worried about their skin. And that could be. Verse number 12: **'By this I know, that you have had a good will for me: because my enemy shall not triumph over me.'** In other words, Brett Kavanaugh's confirmation will prove God's favor on him. Verse number 13: **'But you have upheld me by reason of my innocence and have established me in your sight forever.'** That's an interesting word, 'innocence'. Brett Kavanaugh has used that word 'innocence' over and over again describing his attitude as far as women go. In fact, he said he was a virgin, I believe, even into college. That's not surprising for someone raised as a strict Catholic. Alcohol is a problem for Catholics; I know I'm a Catholic myself. But as far as sex goes, we are taught to toe the line as far as the Ten Commandments go. I believe they are smearing Brett Kavanaugh. These are all lies. **'Satan was a liar from the beginning'** as Jesus said. But Jesus also said **'Satan was a murderer from the beginning.'** We need to pray for Brett Kavanaugh's safety according to Psalm number 40.

And verse number 14: **'Blessed be the Lord the God of Israel from eternity to eternity. Amen and amen.'** Now, that ending, by the way, I took from the King James Bible. Some of this translation is from the King James Psalm 41, which is the same as the Douay-Rheims 40, as I said before. But who is this God of Israel? If you watch my series on Isaiah 45 and Micah 5, which are all about the conversion of Donald Trump to Catholicism and his Protestant brethren to Catholicism, the 'God of Israel' is a code word in these End Times prophecies for the God of the remnant Catholic Church. And I believe the same here. This Catholic version of Psalm 40, I believe, is a prophecy about Brett Kavanaugh; and thank you, Ashley Kavanaugh, for bringing this to our attention. And we need to take this very seriously, although in the end, Psalm 40 says that Brett Kavanaugh will be confirmed.
