Pope Benedict: Church on Verge of Capsizing

I came across another very interesting article in LifeSiteNews over the weekend and quite a few people have already commented on this on YouTube, but I thought I would give you my spin because they really don't tell you the significance.



Here is the headline and the title and I'll show you this picture of Pope Benedict because he made a very interesting statement at the funeral of one of the four Dubia Cardinals where he very subtly criticized Pope Francis, who I call Cardinal Bergoglio, and the headline is: 'Breaking, Pope Benedict XVI says Church is on the verge of capsizing' and he chose that word 'capsizing' because he is talking about the barque of Peter, in other words, the Catholic Church as a boat headed up by the Pope, and therefore he is specifically criticizing Pope Francis although in, as I say, a very subtle way. And, by the way, don't you think Pope Benedict looks very healthy there?

And I looked up another picture of him, and here is Pope Francis and Pope Benedict; now don't tell me that Pope Benedict is not in perfectly



good health. I mean he is an older person but I really don't see why he resigned except, I believe, the Lord told him to resign; in other words, the Lord told him to respond to the pressure put upon his office because we do not deserve any better than the False Prophet.

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Almighty God appointed Francis just as He will appoint the Antichrist. So here goes this article, this is by Claire Chretien, and she's a very good writer, very good looking, by the way, too: 'Pope Benedict XVI sent a sobering message at the funeral of Cardinal Joachim Meisner today saying he was moved at the Dubia Cardinal's ability (in other words he's praising one of these four Dubia Cardinals; they wrote a letter of doubt to Pope Francis asking him to explain what he meant in Amoris Laetitia when he said there were possible times in which Holy Communion could be given to people living in mortal sin and, of course, he has not responded) the Cardinal's ability to live out a deep conviction that the Lord does not abandon his church even when the boat has taken on so much water as to be on the verge of capsizing.'

And this 'capsizing' is prophesied in the book of Revelation, chapter 11, verse number 2, where the 'Holy City', the Holy City in the End Times is Rome, is being trampled underfoot by the Gentiles; and Mary also prophesied it at La Salette where she said 'Rome will lose the faith and become the seat of the Antichrist'. 'The church stands in particularly pressing need of convincing shepherds who can resist the dictatorship of the spirit of the age (well, Pope Francis goes along with a spirit of the age) and who live and think the faith with determination, Pope Benedict said in a message read by Archbishop George Ganswein, his personal secretary, and head of the papal household. Because of this pressing need, Meisner found it difficult to leave his post. What moved me all the more was that in the last period of his life now (this is Pope Benedict speaking) he learned to let go and to live out a deep conviction that the Lord does not abandon his church even when the boat has taken on so much water as to be on the verge of capsizing" Pope Emeritus concluded. As I say, we have two popes in the Vatican; they both have the title of Pope, they both dress like popes, they both carry out papal duties. But the church teaches there can only be one true Pope; one is true, the other is false, and this is a test from Almighty God, so that we determine who is true and who is false.

'Messner, who was eighty-three, was one of the four Cardinals who sent Pope Francis a Dubia consisting of five questions asking if Amoris Laetitia is aligned with Catholic morality. He died while awaiting the Pope's response. Although Pope Francis hasn't answered the Dubia (of course not) he has given his approval to interpretations of the controversial exhortation that say those living in adulterous unions may receive Holy Communion.' And in fact, the bishops on Malta say people living in fornication, who are not married, either a first, second or third time, can receive Holy Communion. And, of course, as I have explained before, and none of these conservative sites are going to explain the problem, that will invalidate the Eucharist: Jesus will not enter into the bread and wine consecrated by a priest if his intention, and the intention of the Church, is to give Holy Communion to those living in mortal sin.

And already the Eucharist is not valid in Germany, nor is it valid in Malta. It is, however, still valid in Poland because the Bishops in Poland have publicly disavowed Pope Francis and that is what your priest and my priest must also do if he wants his consecrations to be valid (1). 'Pope Benedict also mentioned in the statement that he had spoken to Cardinal Meisner on the telephone the day before his death. (that's interesting!) Canon lawyer Kurt Martens said Pope Benedict's message was an amazing yet diplomatic form of support for the Dubia Cardinals.' And it was also a rebuke of Pope Francis. As I say, that's why he said the Church is in the danger of capsizing. That's a naval term; it refers to the barque of Peter. It was an underhanded attack, in my opinion, on the current Pope Francis, even though Pope Benedict supports him and he does that because he knows Francis was appointed by Almighty God and God is also going to appoint the Antichrist and the reason is because none of us, Catholics, Protestants, Orthodox or anyone else, we do not deserve leaders better than the Antichrist or the False Prophet.
