

Warning: You may need to Leave Your Families

On this program I would like to reply to two letters I received this week: one from England and one from here, in the United States.

And from Pennsylvania, Linda writes: 'I have watched your videos on You Tube and have enjoyed them very much. I need a question answered. Why is it that when I bring up Jesus, the Rapture or the book of Revelation, everyone in my family except my husband and brother, tell me I am nuts. They won't bring anyone around me, because when I meet someone for the first time I always ask if they know Jesus Christ. I don't preach, but even if they are not Catholic, I give them a rosary and instructions on how to recite the decades. Why are members of my own family embarrassed of this action, and most of them won't even listen?'

I'm not surprised at this Linda, because the situation is the same in my own family. When I started this ministry, the Lord told me I needed to meet people who have a like mind, and one of the great benefits of making videos for You Tube is, I have met so many people who are of a like mind, on the Rapture, on the book of Revelation, and on prophecies of the End Times. If your family is not receptive, as mine was not, then you need to find new people who will appreciate your viewpoint.

And Linda continues, 'I used to attend Mass every week, but then I had to find a new church, because the priest used the pulpit for an hour comedy act. The other churches were no better and some were far worse. Again Linda, I have found myself in the exact same situation. My only requirement for Novus Ordo Mass is that the priests allow me to kneel for Communion, and believe me it's difficult to find a priest who does not insist that you stand for Communion. Fortunately, the priest in my own parish church allows me to kneel, but many other priests have not allowed me to attend their services.

And Linda continues, 'I can feel something is very close. The spirit has been talking to me a lot lately, and what He is saying is disturbing. He tells me some members of my family are not of me, and I should cut them out of my life, for there are others who would be open to me. Could this be right?' I definitely think it is right Linda. 'Is this message from God?' Yes I believe it is from God. 'He told me to abandon my children. They are grown adults, but the spirit fills my mind with

thoughts of maybe others are more deserving of my time, because they wouldn't laugh at me and think I am crazy.'

Let me tell you of my own experience along this line. Just a few weeks ago, I was invited to a family function, and I was all set to go. My truck was all packed and ready, and at the last minute, the Lord gave me a case of the gout, and I was not able to attend. By the afternoon I was a well again already, so I know the Lord was giving me a message. So I believe definitely Linda, you do have to abandon your own closest members of your family, and find people who appreciated your understanding of these End Times.

And now let me respond to a letter from London, England. And Tracy writes from England, 'Dear Mr Tapley, I am compelled to write to you, after watching your videos on You Tube. You say we have to prepare ourselves. How in the world do we do that? Imagine if everybody had to be chipped in order to buy or sell or live somewhere. I would become a fugitive. Where would I go? What would I do? That is my question.'

Tracy we need to be open to what our Lord is telling us, for each individual situation. It will be completely different. And Tracy says, 'I am scared, petrified, in fact. I am willing to place my life in God's hands and do whatever is required to be free.' Tracy I believe you have answered your own question.

Fear, in these End Times, according to Saint John in the book of Revelation, is a great sin. God reveals the future to us, not to scare us, but to prepare us. Only faith will get us through these End Times. Do not put your trust in hiding guns or hoarding gold. Material objects will not save us. Only complete and total trust in the Lord will help us overcome our fear.

So in conclusion, for both Linda and Tracy, I believe the answers to your questions are in your own letters. We must trust in the Lord in these End Times, and not in members of our own family. We must develop a very good sense of hearing of what He is trying to tell us.
