

## Obama Meets Putin at Ireland Summit

Yesterday, President Vladimir Putin of Russia met with President Barack of the Obama United States at the G8 conference in Northern Ireland. The last time these two world leaders met was in Los Cabos, Mexico, one year ago. Since then, relations between the United States and Russia have deteriorated considerably, primarily over the issue of Syria.

As you know, in Bible prophecy, Daniel, chapter number 11, 'the last King of the South' who is Barack Obama, will provoke 'the last King of the North' who is Vladimir Putin into worldwide global warfare. Now, both of these world leaders are polished performers on the world stage. They know enough not to express their emotions, at least, they try not to. Let's take a look at what Obama said about the situation in Syria.



*'And with respect to Syria; we do have different perspectives on the problem, but we share an interest in reducing the violence, securing chemical weapons, and ensuring that they are neither used or are they subject to proliferation. And that we want to try to resolve the issue through political means if possible and so we will instruct our teams to continue to work on the potential of a Geneva follow up to the first meeting.'*

It's interesting that last year at Los Cabos, President Obama gave almost the exact same 38 second long speech, as he gave yesterday.

However, if you look at the body language of these two men, I think you will find that they were much more relaxed last year than this year.



*And finally as Mr President has mentioned, we discussed Syria, where we agreed that we need to see a cessation of the violence and a political process has to be created to prevent civil war, and to prevent the deaths that we've seen over the last several weeks, and we pledge to work with other international actors including the United Nations, Kofi Annan, and all interested parties, in trying to find a resolution to this problem.*

There is no doubt, we are much closer to the Daniel 11 War this year, than last year, and President Obama tried to kind of break the ice between these two leaders, when he closed this news conference with some comical remarks about judo and basketball, and getting older.

*'And finally we compared notes on President Putin's expertise in judo and my declining skills in basketball, and that we both agreed that, as you get older, it takes more time to recover.'*

Of course, 'the last King of the South', Barack Obama can't really put anything over on 'the last King of the North', Vladimir Putin, no matter how hard he tries. And Vladimir Putin very accurately recognized what Obama was doing and he said, 'you are just trying to relax me'.

(Putin talks in Russian) *'The President wants to relax me with his statements; that of the age remarks.'*

Now earlier, President Obama addressed some youth in Belfast, Northern Ireland, and he suggested that the solution to their problems

is completely different than in Syria and he suggested they should close their Catholic schools. Really, Mr Obama? Here in the United States, government schools wish they could be as good as Catholic schools, and incidentally do you send your daughters to public schools Mr Obama?

*'If towns remain divided. If Catholics have their schools and buildings and the Protestants have theirs, if we can't see ourselves in one another, if fear or resentment are allowed to harden, that encourages division. It discourages cooperation.'*



So it would seem that President Obama's solution to the problems in Northern Ireland is to close Catholic schools, whereas the solution to the problems in Syria is to send in more guns and bullets. As I said five years ago, when I first came on YouTube, Barack Obama will be a man of war, not a man of peace.
