I-1 Thus says the Lord to my anointed Cyrus, whose right hand I have taken hold of, to subdue nations before his face, and to turn the backs of kings, and to open the doors before him, and the gates shall not be shut.

I-5 I am the Lord, and there is none else: there is no God, besides me: I girded you, and you have not known me.

I-3 And I will give you hidden treasures, and the concealed riches of secret places: that you may know that I am the Lord who call you by your name, the God of Israel.

I-11 Thus says the Lord the Holy One of Israel, his maker: Ask me of things to come, concerning my children, and concerning the work of my hands give you charge to me.



M-1 Now shalt you be laid waste, O daughter of the robber: they have laid siege against us, with a rod shall they strike the cheek of the judge of Israel.

M-5 And this man shall be our peace, when the Assyrian shall come into our land, and when he shall set his foot in our houses: and we shall raise against him seven shepherds, and eight princes.

M-3 Therefore will he give them up even till the time wherein she that travails shall bring forth: and the remnant of his brethren shall be converted to the children of Israel.

M-7 And the remnant of Jacob shall be in the midst of many peoples as a dew from the Lord, and as drops upon the grass, which waits not for man, nor tarries for the children of men.



I-17 Israel is saved in the Lord with an eternal salvation: you shall not be confounded, and you shall not be ashamed for ever and ever.

I-22 Be converted to me, and you shall be saved, all ye ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is no other.

I-2 I will go before you, and will humble the great ones of the earth: I will break in pieces the gates of brass, and will burst the bars of iron.

I-4 For the sake of my servant Jacob, and Israel my elect, I have even called you by your name: I have made a likeness of you and you have not known me.

I-6 That they may know who are from the rising of the sun, and they who are from the west, that there is none besides me. I am the Lord, and there is none else.

I-12 I made the earth: and I created man upon it: my hand stretched forth the heavens, and I have commanded all their host.



I-18 For thus says the Lord that created the heavens, God himself that formed the earth, and made it, the very maker thereof: he did not create it in vain: he formed it to be inhabited. I am the Lord, and there is no other.

I-23 I have sworn by myself, the word of justice shall go out of my mouth, and shall not return.

I-7 I form the light, and create darkness, I make peace, and create evil: I the Lord that do all these things.

I-13 I have raised him up to justice, and I will direct all his ways: he shall build my city, and let go my captives, not for ransom, nor for presents, says the Lord the God of hosts.

I-19 I have not spoken in secret, in a dark place of the earth: I have not said to the seed of Jacob: Seek me in vain. I am the Lord that speak justice, that declare right things.

I-24 For every knee shall be bowed to me, and every tongue shall swear.



M-10 And it shall come to pass in that day, says the Lord, that I will take away your horses out of the midst of you, and will destroy your chariots.

M-13 And I will pluck up your groves out of the midst of you: and will crush your cities.

M-2 And you, Bethlehem Ephrata, are a little one among the thousands of Juda: out of you shall he come forth unto me that is to be the ruler in Israel: and his going forth is from the beginning, from the days of eternity.

M-4 And he shall stand, and feed in the strength of the Lord, in the height of the name of the Lord his God: and they shall be converted, for now shall he be magnified even to the ends of the earth.

M-6 And they shall feed the land of Assyria with the sword, and the land of Nimrod with the spears thereof: and he shall deliver us from

the Assyrian, when he shall come into our land, and when he shall tread in our borders.



I-8 Drop down dew, ye heavens, from above, and let the clouds rain the just: let the earth be opened, and bud forth a savior: and let justice spring up together: I the Lord have created him.

I-14 Thus says the Lord: The labour of Egypt, and the merchandise of Ethiopia, and of Sabaim, men of stature shall come over to you, and shall be yours: they shall walk after you, they shall go bound with manacles: and they shall worship you, and shall make supplication to you: only in you is God, and there is no God besides you.

I-20 Assemble yourselves, and come, and draw near together, ye that are saved of the Gentiles: they have no knowledge that set up the wood of their graven work, and pray to a god that cannot save.

I-25 Therefore shall he say: In the Lord are my justices and empire: they shall come to him, and all that resist him shall be confounded.

I-9 Woe to him that gainsays his maker, a sherd of the earthen pots: shall the clay say to him that fashions it: What are you making, and your work is without hands?



M-8 And the remnant of Jacob shall be among the Gentiles in the midst of many peoples as a lion among the beasts of the forests, and as a young lion among the flocks of sheep: who when he shall go through and tread down, and take, there is none to deliver.

M-11 And I will destroy the cities of your land, and will throw down all your strong holds, and I will take away sorceries out of your hand, and there shall be no divinations in you.

M-14 And I will execute vengeance in wrath and in indignation among all the nations that have not given ear.

M-9 Your hand shall be lifted up over your enemies, and all your enemies shall be cut off.

M-12 And I will destroy your graven things, and your statues out of the midst of you: and you shalt no more adore the works of your hands.



I-15 Verily you are a hidden God, the God of Israel the savior.

I-21 Tell ye, and come, and consult together: who has declared this from the beginning, who has foretold this from that time? Have not I the Lord, and there is no God else besides me? A just God and a savior, there is none besides me.

I-26 In the Lord shall all the seed of Israel be justified and praised.

I-10 Woe to him that says to his father: Why do you beget? and to the woman Why do you bring forth?

I-16 They are all confounded and ashamed: the forgers of errors are gone together into confusion.
