

Seven Thunders

Quite a few of my YouTube subscribers have been asking me to do a video on all of the strange sounds which are being heard around the world. In fact, on YouTube there are about 32,000 videos posted on this topic alone. So far I have been reluctant, and the reason is because they do not sound like trumpets even though many people are describing them as the trumpets of the Apocalypse.

But I did get a very interesting message from 'jamiyoungsongs', now he's in England, and this is what he wrote: *"So are the two witnesses in Revelation, chapter 11, Enoch and Elijah? As they are here 1260 days or 3.5 years. And if so, what I make of it, is that people on the earth find out the earthquakes the tsunamis etc. that have taken place over the last two years, have been caused by these two people."* And I answered Jamie and I said: *"Yes the two witnesses in Revelation Are Enoch and Elijah, but no they have not been causing the earthquakes."*

Now, I can see his point, Enoch and Elijah are killed and the people of the world rejoice because they have been causing plagues, etc. So here's Jamie's response: *"If they are not causing earthquakes etc. then what is the power given to them?"* And that got me thinking, is it possible that Enoch and Elijah are causing all of these strange sounds? And if that is true, then these are not the seven trumpets of the Apocalypse, these are the seven thunders of the Apocalypse.

First let's take a look and see where Enoch and Elijah are found in the Book of Revelation, in Revelation 7:2, **"And I saw another angel** (now, this is the prophet Elijah; sometimes Enoch and Elijah are described as angels in the Bible, sometimes as Saints, sometimes as men) **ascending from the rising of the sun** (we know this is Elijah because he came from east of Jerusalem) **having the seal of the living God** (this is Elijah's primary job, to seal the 144,000 converted Jews) **and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels to whom it was given to hurt the earth and the sea."** So Elijah does cry out with a loud voice, but I don't believe he is causing these thunders.

Let's look and see where Enoch is found in the Book of Revelation, in Revelation 10:1, **"And I saw another mighty angel** (this is the prophet Enoch) **come down from Heaven clothed with a cloud, and a rainbow was on his head, and his face was it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire."** We know this is the prophet Enoch, because he lived 365 years, and the sun imagery in this case refers to a solar calendar of 365 days. Another of Enoch's main jobs on this earth, when he is prophesying in the End Times, is to give the timing of events. Whenever Enoch and Elijah are talking to each other, for example,

Elijah often asks Enoch what will be the timing of the events in these End Times.

Another clue that Enoch is involved with telling us the timing of events in the End Times, is that in this description there is a passage of time: first we see a cloud, then we see a rainbow, and then we see the sun. Verse number 2: **“And he had in his hand a little book open, and he set his right foot on the sea and his left foot on the earth** (this is a good indication of Enoch’s mission to the far off Gentile nations, both sea nations and land nations) **and he cried with a loud voice as when a lion roars** (could this be referring to the seven thunders?) **and when he cried seven thunders uttered their voices. And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write, and I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered and write them not.”** And on this program I am going to reveal the meaning of those seven thunders.

So now, we see that the seven thunders, in the Book of Revelation, are not actually cried out by Enoch. Enoch roars like a lion, but the seven thunders come from heaven. In order to find out what these seven thunders mean, we need to discover where Enoch and Elijah are found in the book of Daniel. Daniel 4:13, (I’m going to use the King James version numbering of this chapter, because I believe it’s more accurate than the Catholic Douay-Rheims Bible) **“I saw in the visions of my head on my bed, and behold, a watcher (the watcher is Enoch) and a holy one (the holy one is Elijah) come down from heaven”**.

At one time I thought the Watcher and the Holy One were the same individual, but I’ve come to realize these are the two witnesses of the End Times: these are the two lamp stands, Enoch and Elijah. **“And he cried aloud** (Daniel writes here ‘he’ cried aloud, so that means that one of these two witnesses is doing the crying) **and said thus, cut down the tree** (this tree in the King’s vision symbolizes King Nebuchadnezzar himself) **and chop off the branches thereof, shake off its leaves and scatter its fruits, let the beasts fly away from under it and the birds from its branches.”** We are going to determine that this is Elijah who spoke these words by a process of elimination because the next passage is definitely from the prophet Enoch. This tree that is cut down was an image of King Nebuchadnezzar, and as Daniel explains, it refers to him losing his power as the king. But in the End Times interpretation, the King, Nebuchadnezzar prefigures Barack Obama, and the tree which is cut down prefigures the fall of the United States and, in fact, all of Western Civilization.

However, I don’t believe what the prophet Elijah is crying out in this passage refers to the seven thunders. First of all there are only six

items mentioned here. And second of all, it is Elijah who is doing the crying. Remember, the seven thunders come from heaven. Let's look a little further and see what Enoch says, verse 15: ***“Nevertheless leave the stump of its roots in the earth and let it be tied with a band of iron and brass among the grass, that is without, and let it be wet with the dew of heaven and let his portion be with the wild beasts in the grass of the earth.”***

Now, there are six items here and this is the prophet Enoch. So how do we know this is the prophet Enoch? Let's read verse 16, ***“Let his heart be changed from man's, and let a beast's heart be given to him and let seven times pass over him.”***

So the key word here is seven, because as I said, Enoch's mission is to give the timing of events and he is saying here that the Tribulation period lasts seven years. And he adds three more descriptions of the Tribulation in this passage to the six previous descriptions for a total of nine. But the nine descriptions which Enoch gives in this passage refers to life during the seven years of Tribulation, that is, after World War 3, and, once again, we see that this is probably not the seven thunders because Enoch lists a total of nine items and they are given by the prophet himself.

Next, let's look and see where Daniel describes the seven years of Tribulation in Daniel's interpretation of the King's dream; verse 25: ***“That they shall drive you out from men, and your dwelling shall be with the cattle and the beasts of the field.”*** Here I am using the Catholic Douay Rheims translation, which distinguishes between beasts and cattle and which is correct, because cattle represents domesticated animals, and the beasts are, of course, the wild beasts of the field: and in the end time interpretation, the two beasts are the Antichrist and the False Prophet. ***“And they shall make you to eat grass as oxen, and they shall wet you with the dew of heaven, and seven times shall pass over you. Till you know that the most high rules in the kingdom of men and gives it to whomsoever he will.”*** This 'whomsoever' is the Antichrist and elsewhere Daniel describes him as the “basest of men” (4:14).

So, in this passage Daniel is describing the same seven years of Tribulation. However I do not believe these are exactly the seven thunders because first of all, they are enunciated by Daniel so they are not enunciated by heaven. And, in this passage there are eight items referred to. Let's look a little further ahead in Daniel and see if we can find the seven thunders. We've seen Enoch describe six plus three aspects of the seven years of Tribulation. We've seen Daniel describe eight aspects of the seven years of Tribulation.

Now let's see if we can find what the seven thunders say. In verse 31: ***“While the word was in the king's mouth, there fell a voice from heaven*** (now, we are on the right track!) ***saying O King Nebuchadnezzar, to you it is spoken, the kingdom is departed from you*** (verse 32:) ***and they shall drive you from men”*** number 1, ***“and your dwelling shall be with the cattle”***, number 2, ***“and the beasts of the field”*** number three, ***“they shall make you eat grass as oxen”*** number four, ***“and seven times shall pass over you”***, number five, ***“until you know that the most high rules”***, numbers six, ***“in the kingdom of men”*** number seven, ***“and gives it to whomsoever he will”***. These are the seven thunders of the End Times (1).

So now, we have finally found the meaning of the seven thunders. First of all, they are associated with Enoch, but they are not enunciated by Enoch. These seven thunders come down from Heaven, very much like the thunders we are hearing around the world. Although associated with the prophet Enoch, they are a warning from Almighty God. Secondly, what is really important about these seven thunders is that they are directed at the general population. That is at you and me. They're not directed at the government, nor are they directed at religion, because it's interesting to see what is left out of the seven thunders.

We have seen these seven years of Tribulation described by the prophet Enoch and by the prophet Daniel. But there are four items left out of the seven thunders which come down from Heaven. Let's take a look at what is left out of the seven thunders. Enoch referred to the stump, which is Western Civilization after it is cut down by World War 3. The band of iron refers to the one-world government; the band of brass is the one world religion. These two bands restrict the growth of Western Civilization.

Now, both Daniel and Enoch refer to the phrase “wet with the dew of heaven”. The seven thunders also left out “wet with the dew of heaven” and I believe the reason is because to add that would, of course, give you eight thunders. And besides it's similar to eating grass as oxen. Remember, these seven are warnings to mankind and not to the government or to religion as these first three are: the stump, the band of iron and the band of brass. “Wet with the dew of heaven” refers to the problems that you and I will face during the seven years. Of course I realize that all of these sounds we are hearing around the world may have other explanations. They could be natural, for example, earthquakes. They could be manmade, for example, the “HAARP” device, or they could be hoaxes. I've seen a lot of videos on YouTube which are obviously made to make fun of the real thing. And of course that's typical, Satan often mocks God and imitates what God is doing.

I have not had the opportunity to review all 32,000 videos on YouTube about these strange sounds. I can't tell if they are man-made, a hoax, or if they are natural or supernatural. However, I think if we look back in Revelation at some of the other plagues caused by Enoch and Elijah, I think we can indeed verify that the two prophets are active now on earth, and they are causing the seven thunders. And they are also causing other plagues, Revelation 11, verse number 6, **“These** (this refers to Enoch and Elijah, the two witnesses) **have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy** (and how many images of drought have we seen on YouTube lately?) **and have power over waters to turn them to blood** (another plague that we are witnessing just in the last year and a half) **and to smite the earth with all plagues as often as they will”**.

So in conclusion, my response to ‘jamiyoungsongs’, I’m beginning to agree with you. Some of these plagues and these seven thunders, are being caused by the prophets Enoch and Elijah. As you know, I have stated many times I believe they are here now, along with the Antichrist and the False Prophet. And there's no doubt, these plagues, such as droughts and rivers turning to blood do upset people. And these are one of the reasons Enoch and Elijah will be put to death in Jerusalem. And I believe this will be in the year 2014 (2).
