

Mary Won't Crush Satan??? My Response!!!

On my last program about the Protected Catholics who will be protected by Mary's Rosary and Scapular, I got quite a few dissenting comments, as I always do when I point out that Jesus will defeat the Antichrist with Mary's Rosary and Scapular as his weapons of choice and, as usual, a lot of people say Jesus doesn't need anybody to defeat the Antichrist. Well, of course, that's obvious: Jesus doesn't need anyone. He didn't need to create you or me. Why did He? God is Love, that's the reason. And, He has also appointed Mary, the woman, to crush the head of Satan as prophesied way back in Genesis 3:15.

And don't go by bad translations. Mary, the Woman, is the one destined to crush the Antichrist and his mentor, Satan, and why? Because it will be a very humiliating defeat, that's why. He will be crushed by a little teenaged Jewish girl and, of course, Satan is trying to hide that fact from you from the beginning because he is the Prince of deception. In any case, one of the comments I received was from "manplans- Godlaughs" and I thought I would respond to him on this program. I'm not sure if he's a troll. I'm not sure if he's a real YouTuber or not. But anyway, this is what he wrote: *"There is only a King of Heaven, Queen of Heaven is referenced to in the Old Testament twice as a form of idol worship."* Well, that's not surprising. Satan always tries to pervert the true Gospel and he tries to pervert Mary as the Queen of Heaven.

Now, how do we know Mary is the real Queen of Heaven? All you have to do is read Revelation, chapter 12, where "the woman appears in heaven with a crown on her head". Obviously, that passage is depicting the true Queen of Heaven, so you are wrong right off the bat "man plans and Godlaughs" because there is a real Queen of Heaven. And he goes on and he says: *"No where in Scripture does it say that Jesus needs or has anyone help him defeat the Antichrist. Scripture is clear and not to be twisted."*

Well, I agree with you, Scripture is clear but, End Times Bible prophecy must be interpreted, as I have stated many times on this program. That's because End Times prophecy is a gift from the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit always requires two people, in this case, a Prophet and a Co-Prophet to interpret. And he goes on to quote Thessalonians chapter 2 verse 8, II Thessalonians, *"And then the lawless one will be revealed whom the Lord will consume with the breath of his mouth and*

destroy with the brightness of His coming." But let me point out to you that you have already interpreted this passage. It does not say "Antichrist". Saint Paul says "the lawless one". Now you have interpreted "lawless one" to mean the Antichrist and you are correct but, you have proven that you must interpret this passage.

And the same way with the phrase "the breath of his mouth and the brightness of His coming", that is obviously also symbolic. The "breath of his mouth" would refer to prayers and, in this case, it's Mary's Rosary. "The brightness of His coming" is a visual image and that refers to the Scapular. That is Mary's protection in these End Times. And "manplans-Godlaughs" continues: *"In Revelation 19:15, it clearly states that "he himself will rule".* Of course, Jesus does rule, no argument there. *"It doesn't get much clearer than that."* No, it doesn't.

And the following passage is also clear if you understand what Jesus is talking about. *"Now out of his mouth goes a sharp sword that with it he should strike the nations and he himself will rule with a rod of iron."* Here I can see where you might be confused because you are probably using a bad translation. The King James and many others say a "sharp sword". It should read a "sharp two-edged sword". About a third of the Bible translations are correct. Why is it a "sharp two-edged sword"? Those two edges, once again, refer to the two weapons Jesus will use. I mean it should be clear that there is no real sword coming out of Jesus' mouth. You must interpret that passage. The two edges represent Mary's Rosary and Scapular just as, for example, when David defeated Goliath, he used two weapons: five smooth stones, which represent Mary's Rosary, and a shepherd's sling, which represent Mary's Scapular.

Notice that there is always a duality. Another example: when Judith cut off Holofernes' head she used two sword strokes. Why? Why two sword strokes? Once again, that is a pre-figuring of Mary's Rosary and Scapular. When King Ahasuerus hangs Haman, he uses a 50 cubit high scaffold; that symbolizes the 50 Hail Marys in a Rosary, and the hangman's noose symbolizes Mary's Scapular. Now, certainly King Ahasuerus symbolizes Jesus but again, the two weapons to hang Haman, who symbolizes the Antichrist, and his ten sons, who symbolized the ten king's of the Antichrist, the weapons which defeat those evil people are Mary's Rosary and Scapular, and that is the lesson that we must learn because Almighty God has allowed us to take part in this great victory.

Certainly, it would be no great deal for Jesus to defeat the Antichrist. Remember, back in Genesis 3:15, everything that is done to Satan is humiliating. He is prophesied to eat dust all the days of his life. He's to crawl on his belly all the days of his life and he is to be defeated by a little teenage Jewish girl. All of those are humiliations. Does it make sense God would prophesy that Satan would eat dust and crawl on his belly but then he would become so great that it would take God Almighty Himself to defeat him? That is not logical. Mary is the woman back in Genesis 3:15 and in Revelation 12 who is destined to crush the serpent and his seed.
